Born in Hesse Cassel, Prussia, Christian Ableman was impressed into the army around the age of 16 and was sent to America as a Hessian soldier fighting against the Colonies in the Revolutionary War. Initially landing in Canada in 1778, he was captured and was imprisoned in Fort Ticonderoga in New York. He decided to remain in the new country after the signing of peace, settling in Albany-New York, he married Regina Kanier- a woman of French decent with whom he fathered 12 children. Beginning his career as a Civil Engineer, he eventually held in both Milwaukee and Sauk County, positions in the U.S. Land office, Milwaukee Common Council, Treasurer of the Milwaukee and Prairie Du Chen Railroad, Chairman of the Sauk County Board of Supervisors, School Treasurer of the Excelsior Township and President of Sauk County Agricultural Society. Eventually Williams settled in the Freedom Township to a life of farming. Williams also had a distinguished military career helping to raise the 23<sup>rd</sup> Wisconsin Volunteers during the Civil War. Rising to the rank of Major he served in a number of engagements including the siege of Vicksburg where he was highly praised for his service. Unfortunately not much is known of his mother.
